



Tesla Model X Performance (2020) (USA)

The Tesla Model X Performance (2020) is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2020 replacing the older Tesla Model X Performance (2019). Tesla stopped making the Performance (2020) in 2021 and replaced it with the Tesla Model X Plaid. You can still find Tesla Model X Performance (2020) on the used car market, with prices starting around €65,950.

The Tesla Model X Performance (2020) has a 103 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 507 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 19.3 kWh per 100 km (or 193 Wh/km) — ranked №63 out of 586 electric vehicles.
