The Mercedes EQE 300 is an all-electric rear-wheel drive sedan. It came out in 2022. Mercedes stopped making the 300 in 2023.

The Mercedes EQE 300 has a 98 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 519 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 17.1 kWh per 100 km (or 171 Wh/km) — ranked №51 out of 586 electric vehicles.
