



Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 40 (Europe)

The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 40 is an all-electric rear-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2021. Audi stopped making the 40 in 2024 and replaced it with the Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 45. You can still find Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 40 on the used car market, with prices starting around €40,900.

The Audi Q4 Sportback e-tron 40 has a 82 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 434 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 17.6 kWh per 100 km (or 176 Wh/km) — ranked №180 out of 586 electric vehicles.
