The Volvo C40 Recharge Twin Pure Electric is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2021. Volvo stopped making the Recharge Twin Pure Electric in 2022.

The Volvo C40 Recharge Twin Pure Electric has a 78 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 371 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 20.2 kWh per 100 km (or 202 Wh/km) — ranked №304 out of 586 electric vehicles.
