



Tesla Model X Performance (2019) (USA)

The Tesla Model X Performance (2019) is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2019 replacing the older Tesla Model X P100D. Tesla stopped making the Performance (2019) in 2020 and replaced it with the Tesla Model X Performance (2020). You can still find Tesla Model X Performance (2019) on the used car market, with prices starting around €65,950.

The Tesla Model X Performance (2019) has a 100 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 452 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 21 kWh per 100 km (or 210 Wh/km) — ranked №142 out of 586 electric vehicles.
