# About VinFast VF 9 Plus

The VinFast VF 9 Plus is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2024. Brand new, the car starts around €98,490.

The VinFast VF 9 Plus has a 128 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 748 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 16.4 kWh per 100 km (or 164 Wh/km) — ranked №2 out of 667 electric vehicles.

#### How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The VinFast VF 9 Plus can accelerate from 0 to 60 mph in 6.4 seconds (ranked №354 out of 667 electric vehicles) and reach a top speed of 124 mph.

The car's powertrain delivers up to 300 kW (402 hp) of power and 457 lb-ft of torque.

#### How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the VinFast VF 9 Plus is 419–512 miles (ranked №2 out of 667 electric vehicles) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

# What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The VinFast VF 9 Plus in the USA comes with a CCS Type 1 charging port. It can be charged at home using a standard domestic socket or at any public AC charging station with the compatible cable. It's important to note that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11 kW, resulting in approximately 37 miles of range added per hour of charging.

For significantly faster charging, public DC fast-charging stations are available. Although the car can achieve a maximum DC charging rate of 160 kW, factors such as battery temperature and charge level may affect the actual charging speed.

#### How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

The size and weight specifications for VinFast VF 9 Plus are as follows:

- Length: 201.5 in
- Width: 88 in (including side mirrors) or 81.4 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 66.7 in
- Wheelbase: 123.9 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 6543 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

#### How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

Behind the rear seats of the VinFast VF 9 Plus, you'll find 7.5 cubic feet of storage space (ranked №595 out of 667 electric vehicles).

Folding down the rear seats expands the total cargo capacity to 32.7 cubic feet (ranked №468 out of 667 electric vehicles).

Frunk capacity: The front trunk is called a "frunk", and it offers an additional 2.6 cubic feet for storing small items.

#### Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The VinFast VF 9 Plus is officially rated to tow 3968 lbs. This applies to trailers equipped with brakes.
