About VinFast VF 6 Eco (2024-...)

The VinFast VF 6 Eco (2024-...) is an all-electric front-wheel drive SUV. Production of the car hasn't started yet.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The VinFast VF 6 Eco (2024-...) achieves a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 8.2 seconds (placing it at **Nº65** out of **116** ranked positions, among 820 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and attains a maximum speed of 111 mph.

Its powertrain provides a power output of up to 130 kW (174 hp) and a torque of 184 lb-ft.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

VinFast VF 6 Eco (2024-...) achieves a real-world range of 211 miles, placing it at **Nº155** among **249** ranked positions. However, this range is subject to several influences:

- Speed: Traveling at higher speeds reduces battery life.
- Temperature: Extreme cold or hot weather can affect range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous landscapes decrease range.
- Driving habits: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Feature usage: Climate control and media systems also influence range.

It's important to acknowledge that these are estimations, and your actual driving range may differ. Consider these factors when planning your trip and be ready for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The VinFast VF 6 Eco (2024-...) in the USA comes with a CCS Type 1 charging port. It can be charged at home using a standard domestic socket or at any public AC charging station with the compatible cable. It's important to note that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11 kW, resulting in approximately 35 miles of range added per hour of charging.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

The size and weight specifications for VinFast VF 6 Eco (2024-...) are as follows:

- Length: 166.9 in
- Width: 83.4 in (including side mirrors) or 71.7 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 62.8 in
- Wheelbase: 107.5 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 4321 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

The rear cargo area of the VinFast VF 6 Eco (2024-...) provides 12.4 cubic feet of space when the rear seats are upright (Nº123 out of 157 ranked positions, among 820 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding these seats down unlocks a maximum cargo capacity of 45 cubic feet (Nº119 out of 177 ranked positions, among 820 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

The car doesn't have a "frunk" (front trunk).

Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The car isn't officially rated for towing.
