About VinFast VF 8 Eco (2023)

The VinFast VF 8 Eco (2023) is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2023. VinFast stopped making the Eco (2023) in 2024 and replaced it with the VinFast VF 8 Eco (2024).

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The VinFast VF 8 Eco (2023) achieves a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 6.2 seconds (placing it at №338 among 667 electric vehicles) and attains a maximum speed of 124 mph.

Its powertrain provides a power output of up to 260 kW (349 hp) and a torque of 369 lb-ft.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the VinFast VF 8 Eco (2023) is 193–235 miles (ranked №443 out of 667 electric vehicles) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The VinFast VF 8 Eco (2023) in the USA is equipped with a CCS Type 1 charging port. You can charge it conveniently at home using a standard outlet, or utilize any public AC charging station with the appropriate cable. However, the car's built-in charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging speed to 11 kW, which translates to roughly 26 miles of range added per hour.

For faster charging, use DC fast-charging stations. The VinFast VF 8 Eco (2023) supports a maximum DC charging rate of 150 kW, but it's important to note that battery temperature and current charge level can affect the actual charging speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

VinFast VF 8 Eco (2023) comes in the following dimensions:

• Length: 187 in

• Width: 87.4 in (including side mirrors) or 76.1 in (excluding side mirrors)

• Height: 65.6 in

Wheelbase: 116.1 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)

• Curb weight: 5600 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

The rear cargo area of the VinFast VF 8 Eco (2023) provides 13.3 cubic feet of space when the rear seats are upright (ranked №464 out of 667 electric vehicles).

Folding these seats down unlocks a maximum cargo capacity of 48 cubic feet (ranked №464 out of 667 electric vehicles).

In addition, the car has a frunk, a front compartment with 2.7 cubic feet dedicated to smaller items.

Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The VinFast VF 8 Eco (2023) is officially rated to tow 3968.3 lbs. This applies to trailers equipped with brakes.
