# About Rivian R1S Performance Dual Motor AWD Standard+

The Rivian R1S Performance Dual Motor AWD Standard+ is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2024.

The Rivian R1S Performance Dual Motor AWD Standard+ has a 127.4 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 507 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 23.9 kWh per 100 km (or 239 Wh/km) — ranked №91 out of 667 electric vehicles.

## How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Rivian R1S Performance Dual Motor AWD Standard+ is equipped with a powertrain that delivers up to 496 kW (665 hp) of power and 829 lb-ft of torque.

This enables a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 3.5 seconds (ranked №59 out of 667 electric vehicles) and a top speed of 110 mph.

## How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the Rivian R1S Performance Dual Motor AWD Standard+ is 284–347 miles (ranked №90 out of 667 electric vehicles) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

## What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

In the USA Rivian R1S Performance Dual Motor AWD Standard+ has a CCS Type 1 charge port.

- You can charge it at home using a standard domestic socket or plug into any public AC charging station using the right cable. Keep in mind that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11.5 kW, which translates to approximately 27 miles of range added per hour of charging.

- For quicker charging, consider using a compatible DC fast-charging station. The car boasts a maximum charging rate of 215 kW, but remember that battery temperature and charge level can influence the actual speed you'll experience.

## How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

Rivian R1S Performance Dual Motor AWD Standard+ comes in the following dimensions:

- Length: 200.8 in
- Width: 87.1 in (including side mirrors) or 79.3 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 77.3 in
- Wheelbase: 121.1 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: N/A lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

## How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

Behind the rear seats of the Rivian R1S Performance Dual Motor AWD Standard+, you'll find 5.1 cubic feet of storage space (ranked №617 out of 667 electric vehicles).

Folding down the rear seats expands the total cargo capacity to 79.9 cubic feet (ranked №74 out of 667 electric vehicles).

Frunk capacity: The front trunk is called a "frunk", and it offers an additional 11.1 cubic feet for storing small items.

## Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Rivian R1S Performance Dual Motor AWD Standard+ is officially rated to tow 7700 lbs. This applies to trailers equipped with brakes.
