About Volkswagen ID.3 Pro (2024-...)

The Volkswagen ID.3 Pro (2024-...) is an all-electric rear-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2024. Brand new, the car starts around €39,995.

The Volkswagen ID.3 Pro (2024-...) has a 63 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 369 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 16 kWh per 100 km (or 6.25 km per kWh) — ranked №478 out of 816 electric vehicles.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Volkswagen ID.3 Pro (2024-...) can accelerate from 0 to 60 mph in 7.3 seconds (№56 out of 116 ranked positions, among 816 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and reach a top speed of 99 mph.

The car's powertrain delivers up to 150 kW (201 hp) of power and 229 lb-ft of torque.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the Volkswagen ID.3 Pro (2024-...) is 229 miles (№138 out of 249 ranked positions, among 816 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

In the USA Volkswagen ID.3 Pro (2024-...) has a CCS Type 2 charge port.

- You can charge it at home using a standard domestic socket or plug into any public AC charging station using the right cable. Keep in mind that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11 kW, which translates to approximately 38 miles of range added per hour of charging.
- For quicker charging, consider using a compatible DC fast-charging station. The car boasts a maximum charging rate of 165 kW, but remember that battery temperature and charge level can

influence the actual speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

Here are the dimensions and weight for the Volkswagen ID.3 Pro (2024-...):

- Length: 167.9 in
- Width: 81.5 in (including side mirrors) or 71.2 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 61.6 in
- Wheelbase: 109.1 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 4001 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

Here's a breakdown of the Volkswagen ID.3 Pro (2024-...) cargo space:

- Trunk capacity: With the rear seats up, you get 13.6 cubic feet of cargo space in the back ([Nº109 out of 155 ranked positions](#), among 816 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).
- Max cargo capacity: Fold down the rear seats, and you open up 44.7 cubic feet of total cargo space ([Nº117 out of 173 ranked positions](#), among 816 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).
- Frunk capacity: The car doesn't have a "frunk" (front trunk).
