About Cadillac Escalade IQ First Edition (2024-...)

The Cadillac Escalade IQ First Edition (2024-...) is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. Production of the car hasn't started yet.

The Cadillac Escalade IQ First Edition (2024-...) has a 216 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 703 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 30.3 kWh per 100 km (or 3.31 km per kWh) — ranked N°6 out of 820 electric vehicles.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Cadillac Escalade IQ First Edition (2024-...) achieves a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 5 seconds (placing it at N°33 out of 116 ranked positions, among 820 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and attains a maximum speed of 112 mph.

Its powertrain provides a power output of up to 559 kW (750 hp) and a torque of 785 lb-ft.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Cadillac Escalade IQ First Edition (2024-...) achieves a real-world range of 437 miles, placing it at N°6 among 249 ranked positions. However, this range is subject to several influences:

- Speed: Traveling at higher speeds reduces battery life.
- Temperature: Extreme cold or hot weather can affect range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous landscapes decrease range.
- Driving habits: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Feature usage: Climate control and media systems also influence range.

It's important to acknowledge that these are estimations, and your actual driving range may differ. Consider these factors when planning your trip and be ready for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The Cadillac Escalade IQ First Edition (2024-...) in the USA comes with a CCS Type 1 charging port. It can be charged at home using a standard domestic socket or at any public AC charging station with the compatible cable. It's important to note that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11.5 kW, resulting in approximately 21 miles of range added per hour of charging.

For significantly faster charging, public DC fast-charging stations are available. Although the car can achieve a maximum DC charging rate of 350 kW, factors such as battery temperature and charge level may affect the actual charging speed.

For even faster home charging, an optional 19.2 kW AC on-board charger is available.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

The size and weight specifications for Cadillac Escalade IQ First Edition (2024-...) are as follows:

- Length: 224.3 in
- Width: 94.1 in (including side mirrors) or in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 76.1 in
- Wheelbase: 136.2 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 9064 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

The rear cargo area of the Cadillac Escalade IQ First Edition (2024-...) provides 69.1 cubic feet of space when the rear seats are upright (Nº4 out of 157 ranked positions, among 820 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding these seats down unlocks a maximum cargo capacity of 119.1 cubic feet (Nº10 out of 177 ranked positions, among 820 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

In addition, the car has a frunk, a front compartment with 12.2 cubic feet dedicated to smaller items.

Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Cadillac Escalade IQ First Edition (2024-...) is officially rated to tow 8000 lbs. This applies to trailers equipped with brakes.
