About Hyundai Ioniq 9 Long Range RWD (2025-...)

The Hyundai Ioniq 9 Long Range RWD (2025-...) is an all-electric rear-wheel drive SUV. Production of the car hasn't started yet. The starting price is expected to be around €69,000.

The Hyundai Ioniq 9 Long Range RWD (2025-...) has a 110.3 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 527 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 20.1 kWh per 100 km (or 4.97 km per kWh) — ranked №68 out of 833 electric vehicles.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Hyundai Ioniq 9 Long Range RWD (2025-...) is equipped with a powertrain that delivers up to 160 kW (215 hp) of power and 258 lb-ft of torque.

This enables a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 9 seconds (Nº73 out of 118 ranked positions, among 833 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and a top speed of 115 mph.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

The estimated real-world range for Hyundai Ioniq 9 Long Range RWD (2025-...) is 327 miles, ranking it Nº43 out of 253 ranked positions. Several conditions can influence this range:

- Speed: The battery drains faster at higher speeds.
- Temperature: Extreme temperatures can impact range.
- Terrain: Range is reduced on hilly or mountainous terrain.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving behaviors, such as frequent acceleration and braking, decrease efficiency.
- Feature utilization: Climate control and media system usage also affect range.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The Hyundai loniq 9 Long Range RWD (2025-...) in the USA is equipped with a Tesla (NACS) charging port. You can charge it conveniently at home using a standard outlet, or utilize any public AC charging station with the appropriate cable. However, the car's built-in charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging speed to 11 kW, which translates to roughly 31 miles of range added per hour.

For faster charging, use DC fast-charging stations. The Hyundai Ioniq 9 Long Range RWD (2025-...) supports a maximum DC charging rate of 350 kW, but it's important to note that battery temperature and

current charge level can affect the actual charging speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

Hyundai Ioniq 9 Long Range RWD (2025-...) comes in the following dimensions:

- Length: 199.2 in
- Width: in (including side mirrors) or 78 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 70.5 in
- Wheelbase: 123.2 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 5732 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

Behind the rear seats of the Hyundai loniq 9 Long Range RWD (2025-...), you'll find 21.9 cubic feet of storage space (Nº46 out of 154 ranked positions, among 833 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding down the rear seats expands the total cargo capacity to cubic feet (Nº out of ranked positions, among 833 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Frunk capacity: The front trunk is called a "frunk", and it offers an additional 3.1 cubic feet for storing small items.

Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Hyundai Ioniq 9 Long Range RWD (2025-...) can safely tow up to 5511 lbs, provided that the trailer has its own braking system.
