About Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...)

Overview

The 2025 Zeekr 7X Premium RWD is set to electrify the premium SUV scene, arriving as an 'Announced' model with production kicking off in 2025. This Chinese-built machine targets the European market with a compelling blend of tech and style. For around €53,990 new, you're getting a sharp-looking, rear-wheel-drive SUV boasting an advanced 800V architecture. Key highlights include its potent single motor setup, generous usable battery capacity, and an interior promising a truly upmarket experience, positioning it as a strong contender against established European rivals.

What's New for 2025?

Everything! The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD is an entirely new model for 2025, marking Zeekr's continued expansion into Europe. It rolls in fresh from the factory in China, bringing with it the brand's latest design language and cutting-edge EV technology. The standout feature is its 800V electrical system, promising lightning-fast charging capabilities. This rear-driven Premium variant is engineered to deliver a dynamic yet comfortable driving experience, packed with features aimed squarely at discerning European buyers looking for the next big thing in electric mobility.

Design & Exterior

The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD cuts a dash with its contemporary SUV silhouette, clearly part of the slick Zeekr family. It's a sizeable beast, measuring 4787 mm in length, 1930 mm wide (excluding mirrors), and standing 1650 mm tall, giving it proper road presence. Expect striking LED light signatures front and rear, and likely some stylish alloy wheels specific to this Premium trim. Its clean lines and assertive stance ensure it'll turn heads, showcasing a modern aesthetic that's both sophisticated and a little bit futuristic.

Interior, Tech & Cargo

Step inside the Zeekr 7X Premium RWD, and you're greeted by a cabin designed to impress, with a focus on high-quality materials and a minimalist, tech-forward layout. It comfortably seats five, offering good passenger space. For your luggage, there's a useful 539 litres in the boot, and a rather handy 66-litre frunk for charging cables or smaller bags. While the exact figure for seats-folded capacity isn't specified, expect it to be substantial. A large central infotainment screen will likely dominate the dash, complemented by a digital driver's display, with advanced connectivity features.

Performance & Driving Experience

This Premium RWD version of the Zeekr 7X isn't just about looks; it's got the go to match. The single Permanent Magnet Synchronous Motor (PMSM) kicks out a healthy 310 kW (that's about 416 horsepower!) and 440 Nm of torque, all sent to the rear wheels for that classic engaging drive. It'll sprint from 0 to 100 km/h in a brisk 6 seconds flat, and tops out at 210 km/h. Expect a smooth, responsive powertrain, and with its sophisticated chassis, it should offer a good balance of dynamic handling and ride comfort, with multiple regenerative braking modes to claw back energy.

Range, Battery & Charging

The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD packs a 71 kWh usable battery, good for a Green Cars Compare estimated

real-world range of around 408 km – pretty decent for daily duties and beyond. Efficiency is rated at 5.75 km/kWh. Thanks to its 800V architecture and a CCS Type 2 port, DC fast charging is blisteringly quick, hitting up to 360 kW! Even on a 400V DC charger, it can pull a respectable 200 kW. For AC charging, the standard 22 kW on-board unit means a full top-up can be done in just a few hours. Vehicle-to-Load (V2L) capability is also anticipated.

Safety & Driver-Assistance Features

While an official Euro NCAP safety rating for the 2025 Zeekr 7X Premium RWD is yet to be announced, expect a comprehensive suite of active and passive safety features. Typical for a premium offering, it will likely come equipped with an array of advanced driver-assistance systems (ADAS) as standard. This should include adaptive cruise control, lane-keeping assist, blind-spot monitoring, autonomous emergency braking, and a host of sensors and cameras to keep you and your passengers secure on European roads.

Warranty & Maintenance Coverage

Zeekr is establishing itself in Europe with competitive coverage. Buyers of the 7X Premium RWD can likely expect a comprehensive vehicle warranty, typically around 5 years or 100,000 km. The crucial battery pack should be covered for a longer period, often 8 years or 200,000 km, with a performance guarantee (e.g., retaining at least 70% capacity). Details on powertrain-specific warranty and any complimentary maintenance schedules will be confirmed closer to its EU launch, but reliability is a key focus for the Geely-backed brand.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) is equipped with a powertrain that delivers up to 310 kW (416 hp) of power and 325 lb-ft of torque.

This enables a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 5.7 seconds ([Nº41 out of 119 ranked positions](#), among 971 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and a top speed of 130 mph.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

The estimated real-world range for Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) is 254 miles, ranking it [Nº121 out of 264 ranked positions](#). Several conditions can influence this range:

- Speed: The battery drains faster at higher speeds.
- Temperature: Extreme temperatures can impact range.
- Terrain: Range is reduced on hilly or mountainous terrain.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving behaviors, such as frequent acceleration and braking, decrease efficiency.
- Feature utilization: Climate control and media system usage also affect range.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) in the USA is equipped with a CCS Type 2 charging port. You can charge it conveniently at home using a standard outlet, or utilize any public AC charging station with the appropriate cable. However, the car's built-in charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging speed to 22 kW, which translates to roughly 71 miles of range added per hour.

For faster charging, use DC fast-charging stations. The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) supports a maximum DC charging rate of 360 kW, but it's important to note that battery temperature and current charge level can affect the actual charging speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) comes in the following dimensions:

- Length: 188.5 in
- Width: 82.7 in (including side mirrors) or 76 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 65 in
- Wheelbase: 114.2 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 5280 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

Behind the rear seats of the Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...), you'll find 19 cubic feet of storage space ([Nº73 out of 166 ranked positions](#), among 971 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding down the rear seats expands the total cargo capacity to cubic feet ([Nº out of ranked positions](#), among 971 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Frunk capacity: The front trunk is called a "frunk", and it offers an additional 2.3 cubic feet for storing small items.

Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) can safely tow up to 4409 lbs, provided that the trailer has its own braking system.
