This Performance AWD trim, spearheading the 7X launch, introduces Zeekr's latest advancements in electric mobility. Highlights include its potent dual-motor configuration, a sophisticated 800-volt electrical system for ultra-rapid charging, and what promises to be a tech-laden cabin. As an all-new model, every inch is designed to impress, setting a new benchmark for what drivers can expect from a dynamic and luxurious electric SUV experience.

Design & Exterior

The Zeekr 7X Performance AWD boasts a striking, contemporary SUV silhouette that's both athletic and elegant. Expect sharp lines, a distinctive front fascia with slim, high-tech lighting, and likely some aggressive aero touches unique to this high-octane trim. Rolling on impressive alloys, its commanding presence is undeniable. Key dimensions are a length of 4787 mm, a width of 1930 mm (excluding mirrors), and a height of 1650 mm, giving it a purposeful stance that's ready to turn heads on European roads. It's a proper looker!

Interior, Tech & Cargo

Inside the Zeekr 7X Performance AWD, anticipate a minimalist yet luxurious cabin, dripping with tech and premium materials. Five occupants will enjoy ample space and comfort. Dominating the dash will be a large central touchscreen paired with a sleek digital driver's display, running Zeekr's intuitive OS with modern connectivity like Apple CarPlay and Android Auto. For your gear, there's a generous 539-litre boot, expandable further with seats folded (details TBC), plus a handy 42-litre frunk for charging cables or smaller items. It's a futuristic command centre!

Performance & Driving Experience

Hold on tight! The Zeekr 7X Performance AWD rockets from 0-100 km/h in a blistering 3.8 seconds. This electrifying pace comes courtesy of its dual PMSM electric motors – one at the front, one at the rear – delivering a whopping 470 kW and 710 Nm of instant torque through its all-wheel-drive system. Expect razor-sharp handling befitting the 'Performance' badge, a planted feel thanks to the AWD, and a surprisingly comfortable ride. Multiple regenerative braking modes will allow for efficient one-pedal driving experiences.

Range, Battery & Charging

The Zeekr 7X Performance AWD is equipped with a substantial 94 kWh usable battery pack. Green Cars Compare calculates a real-world range estimate of around 462 km, with an impressive efficiency of 4.91 km/kWh. Thanks to its 800V architecture, DC fast charging is super quick, hitting up to 360 kW to rapidly boost your range when using a compatible 800V charger; it can also accept up to 200 kW on 400V DC chargers. AC charging via its CCS Type 2 port is robust at a standard 22 kW, meaning a full top-up can be done in around 4.5 hours. V2L capability is also expected.

Safety & Driver-Assistance Features

While official Euro NCAP safety ratings for the Zeekr 7X are anticipated closer to its 2025 launch, expect a comprehensive suite of advanced driver-assistance systems. The Performance AWD trim should come loaded with features like adaptive cruise control, lane-keeping assist, blind-spot monitoring, and sophisticated collision avoidance systems, likely part of Zeekr's advanced ADAS package. These cutting-edge technologies will work to keep you and your passengers secure, aiming for top marks in safety assessments and providing a reassuring co-pilot on every journey.

Warranty & Maintenance Coverage

Zeekr typically backs its new European models with a compelling warranty package, and the 7X Performance AWD should follow suit. Expect a comprehensive vehicle warranty, likely around 5 years or 100,000 km, potentially extendable. The crucial battery pack will probably be covered for 8 years or 200,000 km, guaranteeing against significant degradation. With fewer moving parts, EVs like the 7X generally require less maintenance than traditional cars, translating to lower running costs and more time enjoying the drive. Official details for the 7X will be confirmed closer to launch.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Zeekr 7X Performance AWD (2025-...) can accelerate from 0 to 60 mph in 3.6 seconds (№20 out of 119 ranked positions, among 968 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and reach a top speed of 130 mph.

The car's powertrain delivers up to 470 kW (630 hp) of power and 524 lb-ft of torque.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the Zeekr 7X Performance AWD (2025-...) is 287 miles (Nº89 out of 264 ranked positions, among 968 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

In the USA Zeekr 7X Performance AWD (2025-...) has a CCS Type 2 charge port.

- You can charge it at home using a standard domestic socket or plug into any public AC charging station using the right cable. Keep in mind that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 22 kW, which translates to approximately 60 miles of range added per hour of charging.
- For quicker charging, consider using a compatible DC fast-charging station. The car boasts a maximum charging rate of 360 kW, but remember that battery temperature and charge level can influence the actual speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?
