# About Volvo EX30 Cross Country (2025-...)

#### **Overview**

The 2025 Volvo EX30 Cross Country is the rugged, adventure-ready version of Volvo's smallest electric SUV, designed to punch above its weight. It's a compact yet premium package, offering a distinctive take on the electric crossover craze. Key highlights for this plucky Swede include standard all-wheel drive, increased ground clearance for tackling rougher terrain, and unique styling cues. It's positioned as a stylish, eco-conscious choice for those wanting a bit more capability. Expect a European price tag around €57,290 for this top-tier, adventure-focused trim when it hits the showrooms.

#### What's New for 2025?

The big news for 2025 is the arrival of the Cross Country trim itself! This variant transforms the city-slicker EX30 into a mini off-roader. You get an extra dose of attitude with increased ground clearance, chunky black body cladding, and proper skid plates at the front, rear, and sides. Bespoke 19-inch black alloy wheels are available, or opt for 18-inchers with custom tyres for better rough-stuff grip. It's all about adding a dash of trail-conquering ability and visual muscle to Volvo's baby electric, making it ready for more than just the school run.

#### **Design & Exterior**

The EX30 Cross Country keeps Volvo's cool, minimalist Scandinavian design but beefs it up for the wild. You'll spot unique Cross Country elements like protective black cladding, robust skid plates, and distinctive wheel options that scream "bring on the gravel!" The signature Thor's Hammer LED headlights remain, piercing through the gloom. Dimensions are city-friendly at 4233 mm long, 1838 mm wide, and 1573 mm tall – slightly higher thanks to its adventurous suspension lift. It's a proper little tough nut with a premium finish, perfect for urban exploring and weekend escapes.

#### Interior, Tech & Cargo

Step inside the EX30 Cross Country and you're greeted by a stunningly minimalist cabin, crafted with sustainable and recycled materials – very chic, very Volvo. Passenger space is decent for a compact SUV, officially seating five. A single, dominant 12.3-inch portrait touchscreen powered by Google handles almost everything, including wireless Apple CarPlay and Android Auto. For your kit, there's 318 litres of boot space, expanding to 843 litres with seats down, plus a handy 7-litre frunk for charging cables. It's tech-savvy, eco-conscious, and surprisingly practical for its size.

### **Performance & Driving Experience**

This pocket rocket Cross Country means business! With its dual-motor, all-wheel-drive setup, it boasts a mighty 315 kW and a hefty 543 Nm of torque. That translates to a blistering 0-100 km/h sprint in just 3.7 seconds – properly quick! The motor configuration features Permanent Magnet Synchronous Motors (PMSM) both front and rear. Expect nippy handling, loads of grip thanks to AWD, and a comfortable ride, even with the slightly raised suspension. One-pedal driving will make cruising a breeze, and stopping power should be more than ample. It's an eager beaver on any road.

### Range, Battery & Charging

The EX30 Cross Country packs a 64 kWh usable battery, giving you a real-world range estimated by Green Cars Compare at around 357 km – enough for most adventures. Energy efficiency is a respectable 5.58 km/kWh. When it's time to juice up, the standard 22 kW AC on-board charger can top it up fully in roughly 3-4 hours at a compatible station. For rapid top-ups on the go, it gulps down DC power at up to 175 kW via its CCS Type 2 port, getting you from 10-80% in about 26 minutes.

### Safety & Driver-Assistance Features

Volvo and safety go together like meatballs and lingonberry jam! The EX30 secured a top-notch 5-star rating from Euro NCAP. The Cross Country trim comes loaded with kit, including advanced driver-assistance systems. Expect Volvo's Pilot Assist for semi-autonomous driving (adaptive cruise with lane keeping), comprehensive collision avoidance tech covering pedestrians, cyclists, and other vehicles, plus blind-spot monitoring. A new door opening alert to protect cyclists is also a clever touch. It's a little fortress on wheels, keeping you and yours safe as houses.

### Warranty & Maintenance Coverage

Volvo offers solid peace of mind for EX30 Cross Country owners in Europe. You'll typically get a 3year/100,000 km basic vehicle warranty. Crucially, the high-voltage battery is covered for a more generous 8 years or 160,000 km, guaranteeing at least 70% of its original capacity. While specifics on complimentary maintenance can vary by market, Volvo's reputation for reliability is strong. Being a new model, long-term data isn't extensive, but its modern electric platform bodes well for fewer traditional maintenance headaches compared to combustion cars.

### How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Volvo EX30 Cross Country (2025-...) achieves a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 3.5 seconds (placing it at N $^{\circ}$ 19 out of 118 ranked positions, among 953 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and attains a maximum speed of 112 mph.

Its powertrain provides a power output of up to 315 kW (422 hp) and a torque of 400 lb-ft.

# How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Volvo EX30 Cross Country (2025-...) achieves a real-world range of 222 miles, placing it at №152 among 264 ranked positions. However, this range is subject to several influences:

- Speed: Traveling at higher speeds reduces battery life.
- Temperature: Extreme cold or hot weather can affect range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous landscapes decrease range.
- Driving habits: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Feature usage: Climate control and media systems also influence range.

It's important to acknowledge that these are estimations, and your actual driving range may differ. Consider these factors when planning your trip and be ready for potential charging stops.

# What charging options are available? How long does it take to

# charge it?

The Volvo EX30 Cross Country (2025-...) in the USA comes with a CCS Type 1 charging port. It can be charged at home using a standard domestic socket or at any public AC charging station with the compatible cable. It's important to note that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11 kW, resulting in approximately 34 miles of range added per hour of charging.

For significantly faster charging, public DC fast-charging stations are available. Although the car can achieve a maximum DC charging rate of 175 kW, factors such as battery temperature and charge level may affect the actual charging speed.

### How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

The size and weight specifications for Volvo EX30 Cross Country (2025-...) are as follows:

- Length: 166.7 in
- Width: 80 in (including side mirrors) or 72.4 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 61.9 in
- Wheelbase: 104.3 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 4372 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

### How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

The rear cargo area of the Volvo EX30 Cross Country (2025-...) provides 11.2 cubic feet of space when the rear seats are upright (Nº134 out of 163 ranked positions, among 953 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding these seats down unlocks a maximum cargo capacity of 27.8 cubic feet (Nº185 out of 197 ranked positions, among 953 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

In addition, the car has a frunk, a front compartment with 0.2 cubic feet dedicated to smaller items.

# Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Volvo EX30 Cross Country (2025-...) is officially rated to tow 2000 lbs. This applies to trailers equipped with brakes.
