# About Genesis GV60 Standard AWD (2025-...)

## Overview

The 2025 Genesis GV60 Standard AWD is a proper head-turner in the premium electric SUV space. It's the entry ticket to the dual-motor GV60 family, blending futuristic design with a seriously plush interior. Based on the proven E-GMP platform, it offers a compelling mix of performance, comfort, and cutting-edge tech, like its crystal sphere gear selector. It's a stylish alternative to its German rivals, aiming to wow you with character, not just stats. With a new vehicle price of €67,945, it packs a lot of kit for the money, making it a strong contender.

## What's New for 2025?

For 2025, Genesis has streamlined the GV60 lineup, and the big news is under the floor. This Standard AWD model now benefits from the larger 84 kWh battery pack, boosting range and making it an even more capable tourer. This update replaces the previous 77.4 kWh unit, giving all AWD models a welcome endurance upgrade. Genesis has also tweaked feature packaging, potentially making previously optional tech standard for the new model year. Expect the latest infotainment software and refined digital services to keep the tech-forward cabin feeling fresh and intuitive.

## Design & Exterior

The GV60's design is pure sci-fi chic. Its smooth, pebble-like body is punctuated by Genesis's signature quad-lamp lighting front and back. The flush door handles and clamshell bonnet create a clean, futuristic look. This compact SUV measures 4545 mm long, 1890 mm wide, and 1580 mm tall, giving it a sporty, planted stance. While the wilder Performance model gets bigger wheels, the Standard AWD trim still looks sharp and modern. The optional digital side mirrors are a proper party trick, completing the high-tech aesthetic that makes the GV60 stand out.

## Interior, Tech & Cargo

Step inside, and the GV60 wows with its minimalist, upscale cabin. The floating centre console and swivelling Crystal Sphere shifter feel genuinely special. Quality is top-notch, with soft-touch materials everywhere. Tech is dominated by two gorgeous 12.3-inch screens running a slick infotainment system with Apple CarPlay and Android Auto. Space is surprisingly generous for a compact SUV. For your gear, you get a decent 432-litre boot, a handy 53-litre frunk up front, and a massive 1460 litres with the rear seats folded down. It's a truly premium and practical space.

## Performance & Driving Experience

Don't let "Standard" fool you; this GV60 is properly quick. With dual PMSM motors sending a combined 234 kW and a hefty 605 Nm of torque to all four wheels, it'll launch from 0-100 km/h in just 5.5 seconds. It's a smooth, effortless surge of power that's perfect for daily driving and confident overtakes. The ride is beautifully judged, prioritising comfort without feeling sloppy in the corners. You can flick through various regenerative braking levels via paddles, including a brilliant 'i-Pedal' mode for true one-pedal driving around town.

## Range, Battery & Charging

The 2025 model gets a 79.8 kWh (usable) battery, giving it a practical real-world range of 434 km, as calculated by Green Cars Compare, with an efficiency of 5.44 km/kWh. Thanks to its 800V architecture, it's a charging superstar. At a DC fast charger, it can peak at 240 kW, zapping the battery from 10-80% in a blistering 18 minutes. At home, the standard 11 kW AC charger will top it up overnight. It uses a standard CCS Type 2 port and even features Vehicle-to-Load (V2L) technology to power external devices.

## Safety & Driver-Assistance Features

Safety is a huge priority, and the GV60 scores a top-tier 5-star rating from Euro NCAP. Genesis doesn't skimp on the kit, either. The Standard AWD comes loaded with an impressive suite of driver aids. Highway Driving Assist 2 (HDA 2) is a standout, combining smart cruise control with lane-following and even assisted lane changes. Standard features also include Forward Collision-Avoidance Assist, Blind-Spot Collision-Avoidance Assist, and the brilliant Blind-Spot View Monitor, which projects a camera feed into your instrument cluster when you indicate. It's properly comprehensive.

## Warranty & Maintenance Coverage

Genesis rolls out the red carpet with its "5-Year Care Plan." This package is one of the best in the business, including a 5-year, unlimited-kilometre vehicle warranty, which is seriously impressive. On top of that, you get 5 years of complimentary scheduled maintenance and 5 years of roadside assistance. The crucial high-voltage battery is covered for a more industry-standard 8 years or 160,000 kilometres, whichever comes first. This comprehensive coverage provides fantastic peace of mind and makes ownership remarkably hassle-free from the get-go.

## How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Genesis GV60 Standard AWD (2025-...) can accelerate from 0 to 60 mph in 5.3 seconds ([Nº37 out of 119 ranked positions](#), among 995 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and reach a top speed of 124 mph.

The car's powertrain delivers up to 234 kW (314 hp) of power and 446 lb-ft of torque.

## How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the Genesis GV60 Standard AWD (2025-...) is 270 miles ([Nº110 out of 268 ranked positions](#), among 995 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

# What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

In the USA Genesis GV60 Standard AWD (2025-...) has a CCS Type 1 charge port.

- You can charge it at home using a standard domestic socket or plug into any public AC charging station using the right cable. Keep in mind that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 10.9 kW, which translates to approximately 33 miles of range added per hour of charging.
- For quicker charging, consider using a compatible DC fast-charging station. The car boasts a maximum charging rate of 240 kW, but remember that battery temperature and charge level can influence the actual speed you'll experience.

## How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?
