Overview

The 2025 Lucid Air Touring is a stunning slice of the future, slotting perfectly into the lineup as the all-rounder's choice. It masterfully blends the staggering performance Lucid is known for with genuinely usable long-distance range, making it a serious headache for rivals like the Porsche Taycan and Tesla Model S. This dual-motor, all-wheel-drive luxury saloon is engineered for those who crave cutting-edge tech and a premium feel without needing the absolute face-melting pace of its pricier siblings. It's the smart-money pick in the ultra-competitive premium EV space.

What's New for 2025?

For 2025, Lucid has made some properly clever tweaks. The biggest news is the long-awaited introduction of a heat pump, a massive win for European drivers facing chilly winters, as it significantly boosts coldweather efficiency and range. While the core design remains, the Touring benefits from the latest software updates pushed over-the-air, refining the infotainment system and driver aids. This model year also sees a revised powertrain configuration, fine-tuning the balance between its impressive power and class-leading range, keeping it sharp against the competition.

Design & Exterior

The Lucid Air Touring is a design masterpiece, looking like it's slipped out of a sci-fi film. Its incredibly sleek, aerodynamic shape, measuring 4975 mm long, 1936 mm wide, and just 1408 mm tall, helps it cheat the wind. Signature features include the ultra-slim Micro Lens Array headlights and the elegant full-width rear light bar that give it an unmistakable road presence. The Touring trim typically sports unique 20-inch Aero Lite wheels that perfectly complement its futuristic yet understated aesthetic, while the massive clamshell boot and frunk openings are both cool and practical.

Interior, Tech & Cargo

Step inside the Air Touring and you're greeted by a stunningly open and airy cabin. The centrepiece is the curved 34-inch Glass Cockpit display, which feels truly next-generation. Material quality is superb, with a focus on sustainable and luxurious finishes, and there's ample space for five adults. When it comes to storage, it's a packaging marvel, boasting a 456-litre boot and a cavernous 283-litre frunk up front. With the rear seats folded, total cargo space expands to 627 litres. Apple CarPlay and Android Auto are now onboard, making tech integration seamless.

Performance & Driving Experience

Don't let the luxury fool you; the Air Touring is seriously quick. Its dual-motor, all-wheel-drive system, featuring Permanent Magnet Synchronous Motors on each axle, unleashes a combined 462 kW and a staggering 1200 Nm of torque, catapulting you from 0-100 km/h in a blistering 3.6 seconds. On the road, it combines this ferocious acceleration with a supremely comfortable and quiet ride, thanks to sophisticated adaptive damping. The powerful regenerative braking allows for smooth one-pedal driving, making it as effortless in town as it is epic on the motorway.

Range, Battery & Charging

Range anxiety simply isn't a thing here. The Air Touring packs a 92 kWh usable battery, delivering a phenomenal Green Cars Compare estimated real-world range of 659 km thanks to its incredible efficiency of 7.16 km/kWh. Its 900V+ architecture is the real party trick, allowing it to accept up to 250 kW on a compatible DC fast charger. On more common 400V chargers, it still pulls a respectable 50 kW. At home, the standard 22 kW AC on-board charger is class-leading. It all comes through a standard European CCS Type 2 port.

Safety & Driver-Assistance Features

Safety is paramount in the Lucid Air, backed by a top-tier 5-star Euro NCAP rating. Every Touring comes equipped with the comprehensive DreamDrive suite of driver aids as standard. This includes essentials like intelligent adaptive cruise control with lane centering, blind-spot monitoring, and automated emergency braking. For those wanting the absolute cutting edge, the optional DreamDrive Pro package adds more sensors, including LiDAR, unlocking features like a 3D surround-view monitor and paving the way for even more advanced semi-autonomous driving capabilities via future software updates.

Warranty & Maintenance Coverage

Lucid backs the Air Touring with a solid warranty package for peace of mind. In Europe, this typically includes a basic vehicle warranty covering 4 years or 80,000 kilometres. The crucial high-voltage battery and powertrain components are covered for a more substantial 8 years or 160,000 kilometres, with a guarantee to retain at least 70% of the battery's original capacity. While it doesn't come with extensive free maintenance plans, Lucid's focus on over-the-air updates and mobile service technicians aims to make ownership as hassle-free as possible.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Lucid Air Touring (2025-...) can accelerate from 0 to 60 mph in 3.4 seconds (Nº18 out of 120 ranked positions, among 999 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and reach a top speed of 140 mph.

The car's powertrain delivers up to 462 kW (620 hp) of power and 885 lb-ft of torque.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the Lucid Air Touring (2025-...) is 409 miles (Nº11 out of 268 ranked positions, among 999 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

In the USA Lucid Air Touring (2025-...) has a CCS Type 1 charge port.

- You can charge it at home using a standard domestic socket or plug into any public AC charging station using the right cable. Keep in mind that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 19.2 kW, which translates to approximately 77 miles of range added per hour of charging.
- For quicker charging, consider using a compatible DC fast-charging station. The car boasts a maximum charging rate of 250 kW, but remember that battery temperature and charge level can influence the actual speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

- Frunk capacity: The front trunk is called a "frunk", and it offers an additional 10 cubic feet for storing small items.
