



BMW i3 BEV 120 Ah (USA)

The BMW i3 BEV 120 Ah is an all-electric rear-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2018 replacing the older BMW i3 BEV 94 Ah. BMW stopped making the BEV 120 Ah in 2022. The BMW i3 BEV 120 Ah has a 42.2 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 300 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 12.6 kWh per 100 km (or 126 Wh/km) — ranked №417 out of 586 electric vehicles.
