The Chevrolet Bolt EV 2017-2019 is an all-electric front-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2017. Chevrolet stopped making the 2017-2019 in 2019 and replaced it with the Chevrolet Bolt EV 2020-2021.

The Chevrolet Bolt EV 2017-2019 has a 60 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 383 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 14.9 kWh per 100 km (or 149 Wh/km) — ranked N°288 out of 586 electric vehicles.
