



Tesla Model 3 Standard Range Plus (USA)

The Tesla Model 3 Standard Range Plus is an all-electric rear-wheel drive sedan. It came out in 2019 replacing the older Tesla Model 3 Standard Range. Tesla stopped making the Standard Range Plus in 2021 and replaced it with the Tesla Model 3 RWD (2023). You can still find Tesla Model 3 Standard Range Plus on the used car market, with prices starting around €31,400.

The Tesla Model 3 Standard Range Plus has a 55 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 400 km on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 13.1 kWh per 100 km (or 131 Wh/km) — ranked №240 out of 586 electric vehicles.
