The BMW iX 3 is an all-electric rear-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2021. The car is not available on the US market.

The BMW iX 3 has a 80 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 281 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 26.3 kWh per 100 miles (or 263 Wh/mile) — ranked №141 out of 586 electric vehicles.
