



Audi Q4 e-tron 45 (USA)

The Audi Q4 e-tron 45 is an all-electric rear-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2023 replacing the older Audi Q4 e-tron 40. The car is not available on the US market.

The Audi Q4 e-tron 45 has a 82 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 271 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 28.4 kWh per 100 miles (or 284 Wh/mile) — ranked N°173 out of 586 electric vehicles.
