The Smart ForTwo Electric Drive is an all-electric rear-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2017. Smart stopped making the Electric Drive in 2018. The car is not available on the US market.

The Smart ForTwo Electric Drive has a 17.6 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 75 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 22.3 kWh per 100 miles (or 223 Wh/mile) — ranked №564 out of 586 electric vehicles.
