The Zeekr 001 Privilege AWD (2023-...) is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2023. The car is not available on the US market.

The Zeekr 001 Privilege AWD (2023-...) has a 100 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 306 mi on a single charge — ranked №120 out of 816 electric vehicles.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Zeekr 001 Privilege AWD (2023-...) achieves a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 3.6 seconds (placing it at Nº19 out of 116 ranked positions, among 816 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and attains a maximum speed of 124 mph.

Its powertrain provides a power output of up to 400 kW (536 hp) and a torque of 506 lb-ft.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Zeekr 001 Privilege AWD (2023-...) achieves a real-world range of 306 miles, placing it at №63 among 249 ranked positions. However, this range is subject to several influences:

- Speed: Traveling at higher speeds reduces battery life.
- Temperature: Extreme cold or hot weather can affect range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous landscapes decrease range.
- Driving habits: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Feature usage: Climate control and media systems also influence range.

It's important to acknowledge that these are estimations, and your actual driving range may differ. Consider these factors when planning your trip and be ready for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The Zeekr 001 Privilege AWD (2023-...) in the USA comes with a CCS Type 2 charging port. It can be charged at home using a standard domestic socket or at any public AC charging station with the compatible cable. It's important to note that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 22 kW, resulting in approximately 64 miles of range added per hour of charging.

For significantly faster charging, public DC fast-charging stations are available. Although the car can achieve a maximum DC charging rate of 200 kW, factors such as battery temperature and charge level may affect the actual charging speed.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

The size and weight specifications for Zeekr 001 Privilege AWD (2023-...) are as follows:

- Wheelbase: 118.1 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

The rear cargo area of the Zeekr 001 Privilege AWD (2023-...) provides 19 cubic feet of space when the rear seats are upright (N^o69 out of 155 ranked positions, among 816 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding these seats down unlocks a maximum cargo capacity of cubic feet (N^o out of ranked positions, among 816 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

In addition, the car has a frunk, a front compartment with 2.8 cubic feet dedicated to smaller items.

Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Zeekr 001 Privilege AWD (2023-...) is officially rated to tow 4409 lbs. This applies to trailers equipped with brakes.
