About Opel Corsa Electric 50 kWh (2020-2021)

The Opel Corsa Electric 50 kWh (2020-2021) is an all-electric front-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2020. Opel stopped making the 50 kWh in 2021 and replaced it with the Opel Corsa Electric 50 kWh (2021-2023). The car is not available on the US market.

The Opel Corsa Electric 50 kWh (2020-2021) has a 50 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 181 mi on a single charge — ranked №667 out of 843 electric vehicles.

Before 2024, Opel used alternative naming conventions for its electric models. The Opel Corsa Electric was previously called the Opel Corsa-e.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Opel Corsa Electric 50 kWh (2020-2021) can accelerate from 0 to 60 mph in 7.8 seconds (№61 out of 118 ranked positions, among 843 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and reach a top speed of 93 mph.

The car's powertrain delivers up to 100 kW (134 hp) of power and 192 lb-ft of torque.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the Opel Corsa Electric 50 kWh (2020-2021) is 181 miles (№182 out of 253 ranked positions, among 843 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

In the USA Opel Corsa Electric 50 kWh (2020-2021) has a CCS Type 2 charge port.

- You can charge it at home using a standard domestic socket or plug into any public AC charging station using the right cable. Keep in mind that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 7.4 kW, which translates to approximately 26 miles of range added per

hour of charging.

- For quicker charging, consider using a compatible DC fast-charging station. The car boasts a maximum charging rate of 100 kW, but remember that battery temperature and charge level can influence the actual speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

Here are the dimensions and weight for the Opel Corsa Electric 50 kWh (2020-2021):

- Length: 159.8 in
- Width: 77.2 in (including side mirrors) or 69.5 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 56.4 in
- Wheelbase: 99.9 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 3373 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

Here's a breakdown of the Opel Corsa Electric 50 kWh (2020-2021) cargo space:

- Trunk capacity: With the rear seats up, you get 10.9 cubic feet of cargo space in the back ([Nº129 out of 154 ranked positions](#), among 843 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).
- Max cargo capacity: Fold down the rear seats, and you open up 39.5 cubic feet of total cargo space ([Nº139 out of 178 ranked positions](#), among 843 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).
- Frunk capacity: The car doesn't have a "frunk" (front trunk).
