# About Acura ZDX Type S AWD (2024-...)

#### Overview

Acura charges into the EV scene with the ZDX, and the Type S AWD is its electrifying performance flagship! This ain't your grandma's grocery-getter; it's a premium SUV packing a serious punch with standard all-wheel drive and aggressive styling that screams speed. It's gunning for rivals with a blend of luxury and Acura's sporty DNA. Expect to see it hitting showrooms starting at \$73,500 new, with pre-owned examples from the initial launch year already appearing around \$57,400, signaling its fresh arrival on the market.

#### What's New for 2025?

Fresh off its 2024 debut, the 2025 Acura ZDX Type S AWD rolls in largely as a carryover model, which is no bad thing! Acura nailed the formula first time around with this performance EV. So, for 2025, you're getting the same thrilling package, cutting-edge tech, and head-turning design that made its launch a big deal. Think of it as Acura letting us savor the electrifying goodness they've already served up, with no major shake-ups to the winning recipe for this model year.

#### **Design & Exterior**

The ZDX Type S AWD is a real head-turner, flaunting a sleek, performance-oriented design. Up front, Acura's signature Diamond Pentagon grille gets an EV-specific closed-off treatment, flanked by sharp Jewel Eye™ LED headlights. The Type S gets beefier, exclusive gloss black 22-inch alloy wheels and an aggressive stance. It's a sizable machine, stretching 197.7 inches long, 77 inches wide (mirrors folded, folks!), and 64.4 inches tall, looking every bit the modern, sporty SUV ready to carve up the streets with undeniable presence.

#### Interior, Tech & Cargo

Inside, the ZDX Type S AWD offers a driver-focused cockpit with premium materials like Ultrasuede®-trimmed seats giving it that sporty yet luxe feel. There's comfy seating for five. Tech-wise, you're looking at an 11.3-inch central touchscreen with Google built-in, plus wireless Apple CarPlay and Android Auto, paired with an 11-inch digital instrument cluster. For your gear, there's a solid 29.7 cubic feet of trunk space, expanding to a generous 63 cubic feet with the rear seats down. No frunk on this bad boy, though.

## **Performance & Driving Experience**

Hold on tight! The ZDX Type S AWD rockets from 0-60 mph in a blistering 4.3 seconds, thanks to its dual Permanent Magnet Synchronous Motors (one front, one rear) churning out a combined 372 kW and a hefty 544 lb-ft of torque through its all-wheel-drive system. Expect sharp handling from the Type S-tuned adaptive air suspension and serious stopping power from Brembo front brakes. Multiple regenerative braking modes, including one-pedal driving, let you tailor the experience from cruisy to super sporty. It's a proper driver's EV!

## Range, Battery & Charging

The ZDX Type S AWD packs a 102 kWh (usable) battery, delivering a Green Cars Compare calculated real-world range of around 264 miles – enough for plenty of electrifying adventures. Efficiency clocks in at 2.59 mi/kWh. For juicing up, its standard 11.5 kW on-board AC charger can top it up overnight. Hit a DC fast

charger, and you can pump in up to 190 kW via its CCS Type 1 port, getting you significant range in about 30 minutes. Plenty of go, and quick to recharge!

## **Safety & Driver-Assistance Features**

Acura loads the ZDX Type S AWD with safety tech, earning it a top 5-star overall rating from NHTSA. The comprehensive AcuraWatch™ 360+ suite comes standard on this trim. This includes goodies like Hands Free Cruise for relaxed highway journeys, adaptive cruise control, lane keeping assist, blind-spot information, and rear cross-traffic monitoring. So, you can enjoy its potent performance with an extra layer of confidence, knowing the car's got your back with some seriously smart co-piloting features. Peace of mind comes standard!

## **Warranty & Maintenance Coverage**

Acura backs the ZDX Type S with a solid warranty package. Expect a comprehensive new vehicle limited warranty, likely around 4 years/50,000 miles. The crucial battery pack gets robust coverage, typically 8 years/100,000 miles, guaranteeing a certain level of capacity retention. Electric powertrain components are also covered. Plus, Acura often includes complimentary maintenance for the first couple of years or 24,000 miles, making early ownership even sweeter and keeping those running costs impressively low for a performance SUV. Reliability should be strong, leveraging proven EV tech.

## How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Acura ZDX Type S AWD (2024-...) can accelerate from 0 to 60 mph in 4.3 seconds (Nº27 out of 119 ranked positions, among 968 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and reach a top speed of 131 mph.

The car's powertrain delivers up to 372 kW (499 hp) of power and 544 lb-ft of torque.

## How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the Acura ZDX Type S AWD (2024-...) is 264 miles (№112 out of 264 ranked positions, among 968 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

# What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

In the USA Acura ZDX Type S AWD (2024-...) has a CCS Type 1 charge port.

• You can charge it at home using a standard domestic socket or plug into any public AC charging

station using the right cable. Keep in mind that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11.5 kW, which translates to approximately 27 miles of range added per hour of charging.

• For quicker charging, consider using a compatible DC fast-charging station. The car boasts a maximum charging rate of 190 kW, but remember that battery temperature and charge level can influence the actual speed you'll experience.

# How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

Here are the dimensions and weight for the Acura ZDX Type S AWD (2024-...):

## How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

  of 165 ranked positions, among 968 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).
- Max cargo capacity: Fold down the rear seats, and you open up 63 cubic feet of total cargo space (Nº55 out of 200 ranked positions, among 968 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).
- Frunk capacity: The car doesn't have a "frunk" (front trunk).

# Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Acura ZDX Type S AWD (2024-...) has a towing capacity (braked) of up to 3500 lbs (maximum weight the car can tow safely with a trailer that has its own brakes).
