About Škoda Enyaq 85x (2025-...)

The Škoda Enyaq 85x (2025-...) is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2025 replacing the older Škoda Enyaq 85x (2023-2025). The car is not available on the US market.

The Škoda Enyaq 85x (2025-...) has a 82 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 289 mi on a single charge — ranked №229 out of 902 electric vehicles.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Škoda Enyaq 85x (2025-...) achieves a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 6.4 seconds (placing it at **№48 out of 118 ranked positions**, among 902 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and attains a maximum speed of 112 mph.

Its powertrain provides a power output of up to 210 kW (282 hp) and a torque of 501 lb-ft.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Škoda Enyaq 85x (2025-...) achieves a real-world range of 289 miles, placing it at **№82 among 257 ranked positions**. However, this range is subject to several influences:

- Speed: Traveling at higher speeds reduces battery life.
- Temperature: Extreme cold or hot weather can affect range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous landscapes decrease range.
- Driving habits: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Feature usage: Climate control and media systems also influence range.

It's important to acknowledge that these are estimations, and your actual driving range may differ. Consider these factors when planning your trip and be ready for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The Škoda Enyaq 85x (2025-...) in the USA comes with a CCS Type 2 charging port. It can be charged at home using a standard domestic socket or at any public AC charging station with the compatible cable. It's important to note that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11 kW, resulting in approximately 37 miles of range added per hour of charging.

For significantly faster charging, public DC fast-charging stations are available. Although the car can achieve a maximum DC charging rate of 175 kW, factors such as battery temperature and charge level may affect the actual charging speed.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

The size and weight specifications for Škoda Enyaq 85x (2025-...) are as follows:

- Length: 183.4 in
- Width: 84.6 in (including side mirrors) or #WIDTH_WO_MIRRORS_VALUE# in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 63.8 in
- Wheelbase: 108.9 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 4916 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

The rear cargo area of the Škoda Enyaq 85x (2025-...) provides 20.7 cubic feet of space when the rear seats are upright ([Nº57 out of 158 ranked positions](#), among 902 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding these seats down unlocks a maximum cargo capacity of 60.4 cubic feet ([Nº54 out of 186 ranked positions](#), among 902 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

The car doesn't have a "frunk" (front trunk).

Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Škoda Enyaq 85x (2025-...) is officially rated to tow 2645 lbs. This applies to trailers equipped with brakes.
