About Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...)

Overview

The 2025 Zeekr 7X Premium RWD is an all-new electric SUV, marking Zeekr's ambitious push into the premium segment. As an "Announced" model slated for a 2025 production start, primarily for the EU market initially, official US pricing remains under wraps. This rear-wheel-drive variant promises a blend of sophisticated Chinese engineering with a driver-focused experience, aiming to turn heads with its tech and performance. It's one to watch for those seeking a fresh face in the increasingly crowded EV Crossover field, offering a distinct alternative to established players.

What's New for 2025?

GREEN CARS

For 2025, the Zeekr 7X itself is the big news, debuting as a completely new model in the brand's expanding lineup. The Premium RWD trim specifically lands as a core offering, showcasing Zeekr's latest advancements in EV technology and luxury. This means prospective buyers can anticipate cutting-edge battery tech, a state-of-the-art infotainment system, and Zeekr's signature bold design language, all packaged into this fresh electric SUV. As an "Announced" vehicle, every feature it brings will be a new addition to the market upon its release.

Design & Exterior

The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD boasts a striking, contemporary design that's sure to grab attention. Expect sharp, aerodynamic lines and a distinctive front fascia with sleek LED lighting, reflecting Zeekr's high-tech image. This SUV measures a substantial 188.5 inches in length, 76 inches in width (excluding mirrors), and stands 65 inches tall, giving it a commanding presence. The Premium RWD trim will likely feature unique alloy wheel designs and subtle badging, emphasizing its place within the 7X family with a sporty yet elegant stance.

Interior, Tech & Cargo

Step inside the Zeekr 7X Premium RWD, and you'll likely find a cabin dripping with modern luxury and a minimalist aesthetic. High-quality materials should abound, complementing a spacious environment for its 5 occupants. Tech enthusiasts will appreciate a large central infotainment screen and a digital driver's display, likely with seamless smartphone integration (Apple CarPlay/Android Auto expected). For your gear, there's a decent 19 cubic feet of trunk space, plus a handy 2.3 cubic feet frunk for smaller items, making it a practical choice.

Performance & Driving Experience

The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD isn't just about looks; it packs a decent punch too! With its single Permanent Magnet Synchronous Motor (PMSM) powering the rear wheels, you get a solid 310 kW (around 416 hp) and a hefty 325 lb-ft of torque. This setup allows for a brisk 0-60 mph sprint in just 5.7 seconds, topping out at 130 mph. Expect a driving experience that balances comfort with engaging RWD dynamics, along with smooth, adjustable regenerative braking to recapture energy efficiently. It's geared for spirited daily driving.

Range, Battery & Charging

Powering the Zeekr 7X Premium RWD is a 71 kWh usable battery pack, delivering a Green Cars Compare

estimated real-world range of 254 miles. Efficiency is rated at a respectable 3.58 mi/kWh. Thanks to its 800V architecture, DC fast charging is exceptionally quick, maxing out at a blistering 360 kW (or 200 kW on 400V chargers). The standard 22 kW AC on-board charger is also impressively potent. The provided specs list a CCS Type 2 port; for the US, anticipate adaptations for CCS Type 1 or NACS compatibility.

Safety & Driver-Assistance Features

While official NHTSA and Euro NCAP safety ratings for the Zeekr 7X Premium RWD are not yet available as it's an "Announced" model, expect it to be kitted out with a comprehensive suite of advanced driverassistance systems (ADAS). Standard features on this premium trim will likely include adaptive cruise control, lane-keeping assist, blind-spot monitoring, and automated emergency braking. Zeekr aims for top safety credentials, so a robust set of active and passive safety features will be paramount to compete in the US market.

Warranty & Maintenance Coverage

Specific US warranty and maintenance details for the 2025 Zeekr 7X Premium RWD are yet to be announced, as the vehicle is newly announced and initial market availability is listed for the EU. Generally, EVs in this premium category receive comprehensive vehicle coverage around 4-5 years/50,000 miles, with battery warranties typically extending to 8 years/100,000 miles, including a degradation protection clause. Official US powertrain warranty and any complimentary maintenance plans will be confirmed closer to its potential US launch.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) is equipped with a powertrain that delivers up to 310 kW (416 hp) of power and 325 lb-ft of torque.

This enables a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 5.7 seconds (№41 out of 119 ranked positions, among 971 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and a top speed of 130 mph.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

The estimated real-world range for Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) is 254 miles, ranking it №121 out of 264 ranked positions. Several conditions can influence this range:

- Speed: The battery drains faster at higher speeds.
- Temperature: Extreme temperatures can impact range.
- Terrain: Range is reduced on hilly or mountainous terrain.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving behaviors, such as frequent acceleration and braking, decrease efficiency.
- Feature utilization: Climate control and media system usage also affect range.

These figures are approximations, and your actual driving range may vary. When planning trips, consider these factors and be prepared for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) in the USA is equipped with a CCS Type 2 charging port. You can charge it conveniently at home using a standard outlet, or utilize any public AC charging station with the appropriate cable. However, the car's built-in charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging speed to 22 kW, which translates to roughly 71 miles of range added per hour.

For faster charging, use DC fast-charging stations. The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) supports a maximum DC charging rate of 360 kW, but it's important to note that battery temperature and current charge level can affect the actual charging speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) comes in the following dimensions:

- Length: 188.5 in
- Width: 82.7 in (including side mirrors) or 76 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 65 in
- Wheelbase: 114.2 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 5280 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

Behind the rear seats of the Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...), you'll find 19 cubic feet of storage space (Nº73 out of 166 ranked positions, among 971 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding down the rear seats expands the total cargo capacity to cubic feet (N^o out of ranked positions, among 971 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Frunk capacity: The front trunk is called a "frunk", and it offers an additional 2.3 cubic feet for storing small items.

Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Zeekr 7X Premium RWD (2025-...) can safely tow up to 4409 lbs, provided that the trailer has its own braking system.
