About Zeekr 7X Performance AWD (2025-...)

Overview

The 2025 Zeekr 7X Performance AWD is shaping up to be a seriously potent contender in the electric SUV arena, especially for those craving a bit of oomph with their practicality. Announced for a 2025 debut, this all-wheel-drive beast from Zeekr promises a thrilling drive thanks to its dual-motor setup and advanced 800-volt architecture. While official US pricing is still under wraps, as the vehicle is currently listed as 'Announced' with no 'Price New' available in the provided data, expect it to target the premium end of the market if it arrives stateside.

What's New for 2025?

As an entirely new model slated for 2025, the Zeekr 7X itself is the big news! This Performance AWD trim, in particular, bursts onto the scene promising a fresh take on electric SUVs. It leverages Geely's (Zeekr's parent company) formidable SEA platform, packing cutting-edge 800V electrics for super-fast charging and sustained power. For US buyers, this means potentially welcoming a brand-new face in the EV crowd, bringing with it a focus on dynamic driving, a tech-laden cabin, and a distinct design philosophy that's sure to turn heads if it makes its way here.

Design & Exterior

The Zeekr 7X Performance AWD boasts a striking SUV silhouette that's both modern and muscular, as indicated by its 'suv' body style. Expect sleek lines and an assertive stance, likely punctuated by distinctive LED lighting. This specific trim might flex a bit extra with sportier wheels and subtle aero tweaks. Dimensionally, it's a substantial machine, stretching 188.5 inches in length, a solid 76 inches wide (excluding mirrors), and standing 65 inches tall. It's sized to make a statement while navigating city streets with its 114.2-inch wheelbase.

Interior, Tech & Cargo

Step inside the 7X Performance AWD, and you're greeted by a cabin designed for five occupants, aiming for a properly posh and tech-forward vibe. Expect premium materials and a minimalist yet functional layout. For your gear, there's a useful 19 cubic feet of trunk space, plus a handy 1.5 cubic foot frunk up front for smaller items. While the maximum cargo capacity with seats folded isn't specified in the provided data, the available space should prove practical for daily needs and adventures. Infotainment will likely feature large, crisp screens with modern connectivity.

Performance & Driving Experience

Hold on tight, because the Zeekr 7X Performance AWD is engineered to thrill! It rockets from 0 to 60 mph in a blistering 3.6 seconds, with a top speed of 130 mph. This electrifying pace comes courtesy of a potent dual-motor all-wheel-drive system – featuring "PMSM (front), PMSM (rear)" motor types – unleashing a mighty 470 kW (approximately 630 horsepower) and a hefty 524 lb-ft of torque. Expect sharp handling from this 5588 lb SUV, a composed ride, and multiple regenerative braking modes to tailor your drive.

Range, Battery & Charging

The Performance AWD packs a substantial 94 kWh usable battery (100 kWh nominal), delivering a Green

Cars Compare calculated real-world range of 287 miles. It's efficient too, rated at 3.05 mi/kWh. Thanks to its 800V architecture, DC fast charging is mega, peaking at an impressive 360 kW (or 200 kW on a 400V DC charger). The standard on-board AC charger is a powerful 22 kW. The provided data lists a "CCS Type 2" charge port, common in Europe; US versions would likely feature a CCS Type 1 or NACS connector for compatibility.

Safety & Driver-Assistance Features

While official US safety ratings from NHTSA or Euro NCAP are not yet available in the provided data for the Zeekr 7X, expect it to aim for high safety standards. For a new premium EV, particularly a Performance AWD trim, a comprehensive suite of advanced driver-assistance systems (ADAS) would be anticipated. Warranty & Maintenance Coverage

Official US warranty and maintenance specifics for the 2025 Zeekr 7X Performance AWD are yet to be announced, as the vehicle is in its 'Announced' phase and its 'Market Availability' currently lists 'EU' not 'USA'. Should it arrive Stateside, expect coverage competitive with other premium EVs: typically a basic vehicle warranty around 4 years/50,000 miles and a battery warranty for at least 8 years/100,000 miles. Details on complimentary maintenance or specific powertrain coverage for the US market will be crucial information to await.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Zeekr 7X Performance AWD (2025-...) can accelerate from 0 to 60 mph in 3.6 seconds (№20 out of 119 ranked positions, among 990 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and reach a top speed of 130 mph.

The car's powertrain delivers up to 470 kW (630 hp) of power and 524 lb-ft of torque.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the Zeekr 7X Performance AWD (2025-...) is 287 miles (Nº93 out of 268 ranked positions, among 990 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

In the USA Zeekr 7X Performance AWD (2025-...) has a CCS Type 2 charge port.

- You can charge it at home using a standard domestic socket or plug into any public AC charging station using the right cable. Keep in mind that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 22 kW, which translates to approximately 60 miles of range added per hour of charging.
- For quicker charging, consider using a compatible DC fast-charging station. The car boasts a maximum charging rate of 360 kW, but remember that battery temperature and charge level can influence the actual speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?
