About Audi A6 Avant e-tron quattro (2024-...)

The Audi A6 Avant e-tron quattro (2024-...) is an all-electric wagon. It came out in 2024. The car is not available on the US market.

The Audi A6 Avant e-tron quattro (2024-...) has a 100 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 350 mi on a single charge — ranked №48 out of 933 electric vehicles.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Audi A6 Avant e-tron quattro (2024-...) can accelerate from 0 to 60 mph in 4.3 seconds (Nº27 out of 118 ranked positions, among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and reach a top speed of 130 mph.

The car's powertrain delivers up to 340 kW (456 hp) of power and 631 lb-ft of torque.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Real-world range of the Audi A6 Avant e-tron quattro (2024-...) is 350 miles (Nº31 out of 262 ranked positions, among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) — depending on several factors, including:

- Speed: Higher speeds deplete the battery faster.
- Temperature: Extreme cold and hot weather impacts range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous terrain reduces range.
- Driving style: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Use of features: Features like climate control and media system also affect range.

It's important to remember that these are just estimates, and your actual range may vary. It's always best to factor in these various factors when planning your trip and be prepared for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

In the USA Audi A6 Avant e-tron quattro (2024-...) has a CCS Type 2 charge port.

- You can charge it at home using a standard domestic socket or plug into any public AC charging station using the right cable. Keep in mind that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11 kW, which translates to approximately 37 miles of range added per hour of charging.
- For quicker charging, consider using a compatible DC fast-charging station. The car boasts a maximum charging rate of 270 kW, but remember that battery temperature and charge level can

influence the actual speed you'll experience.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

Here are the dimensions and weight for the Audi A6 Avant e-tron quattro (2024-...):

- Length: 194 in
- Width: 84.1 in (including side mirrors) or 75.7 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 57.3 in
- Wheelbase: 116.1 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

The Audi A6 Avant e-tron quattro (2024-...) has a towing capacity (braked) of up to 4630 lbs (maximum weight the car can tow safely with a trailer that has its own brakes).
