## About BMW i5 xDrive40 (2025-...)

The BMW i5 xDrive40 (2025-...) is an all-electric sedan. It came out in 2025 replacing the older BMW i5 xDrive40 (2024-2025). Brand new, the car starts around \$70,100. The car is not available on the US market.

The BMW i5 xDrive40 (2025-...) has a 84.4 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 281 mi on a single charge — ranked №279 out of 933 electric vehicles.

## How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The BMW i5 xDrive40 (2025-...) achieves a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 5.2 seconds (placing it at №36 out of 118 ranked positions, among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and attains a maximum speed of 130 mph.

Its powertrain provides a power output of up to 290 kW (389 hp) and a torque of 435 lb-ft.

## How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

BMW i5 xDrive40 (2025-...) achieves a real-world range of 281 miles, placing it at №93 among 262 ranked positions. However, this range is subject to several influences:

- Speed: Traveling at higher speeds reduces battery life.
- Temperature: Extreme cold or hot weather can affect range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous landscapes decrease range.
- Driving habits: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Feature usage: Climate control and media systems also influence range.

It's important to acknowledge that these are estimations, and your actual driving range may differ. Consider these factors when planning your trip and be ready for potential charging stops.

## What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The BMW i5 xDrive40 (2025-...) in the USA comes with a CCS Type 1 charging port. It can be charged at home using a standard domestic socket or at any public AC charging station with the compatible cable. It's important to note that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11 kW, resulting in approximately 34 miles of range added per hour of charging.

For significantly faster charging, public DC fast-charging stations are available. Although the car can achieve a maximum DC charging rate of 206 kW, factors such as battery temperature and charge level may affect the actual charging speed.

## How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

The size and weight specifications for BMW i5 xDrive40 (2025-...) are as follows:

- Length: 199.2 in
- Width: 84.9 in (including side mirrors) or 74.8 in (excluding side mirrors)
- Height: 59.6 in
- Wheelbase: 117.9 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)
- Curb weight: 5187 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

## How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

The rear cargo area of the BMW i5 xDrive40 (2025-...) provides 17.3 cubic feet of space when the rear seats are upright ([Nº84 out of 161 ranked positions](#), among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding these seats down unlocks a maximum cargo capacity of 27.7 cubic feet ([Nº184 out of 193 ranked positions](#), among 933 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

The car doesn't have a "frunk" (front trunk).

## Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The BMW i5 xDrive40 (2025-...) is officially rated to tow 4400 lbs. This applies to trailers equipped with brakes.
