# About Mazda 6e Long Range (2025-...)

#### Overview

The 2025 Mazda 6e Long Range is Mazda's sleek new all-electric liftback, aiming to inject some zoom-zoom into the EV scene! This Long Range trim promises a sweet spot of usability and Mazda's renowned driving pleasure. While US pricing is still under wraps since it's freshly announced and initially for the EU, expect it to target premium rivals with its stylish Kodo design and rear-wheel-drive setup. It's a sign Mazda is getting serious about electrifying its lineup, and we're here for it! This could be the stylish EV alternative many have been waiting for.

#### What's New for 2025?

The entire Mazda 6e lineup is brand spanking new for 2025, marking a bold leap for the brand into the competitive electric sedan market. This "Long Range" variant is part of its grand debut, showcasing Mazda's commitment to expanding its EV offerings beyond the MX-30. Built on what's rumored to be a new rear-wheel-drive focused architecture, it's designed from the ground up to be an engaging electric drive. Forget incremental updates; this is a fresh chapter for Mazda, blending their design prowess with next-gen electric tech for a properly exciting package.

#### **Design & Exterior**

Get ready to turn heads, because the Mazda 6e Long Range is a proper looker! Penned with Mazda's signature Kodo design philosophy, it's a stunning liftback that oozes sophistication and sporty vibes. Slim LED lights front and rear give it a futuristic edge, while the sculpted bodywork flows beautifully. Dimensionally, it measures a commanding 193.7 inches long, 74.4 inches wide (mirrors tucked), and a sleek 58.7 inches tall. Expect unique aero-efficient wheels on this trim, enhancing its slippery, modern aesthetic that really stands out from the EV crowd.

#### Interior, Tech & Cargo

Slide inside the 6e Long Range, and you're greeted by Mazda's typically plush and driver-focused cabin. Expect top-notch materials, a minimalist yet elegant dashboard, and comfy seating for five. Tech-wise, a large central infotainment screen running Mazda's latest system will feature, complete with standard Apple CarPlay and Android Auto, alongside a crisp digital driver display. When it's time to haul stuff, you've got a practical 11.7 cubic feet in the trunk, expanding to a useful 37.9 cubic feet with seats down, plus a handy 2.5 cubic foot frunk upfront!

### **Performance & Driving Experience**

The 6e Long Range isn't just about looks; it's got the go to match! You'll zip from 0-60 mph in a respectable 7.5 seconds, thanks to its rear-wheel-drive setup powered by a single Permanent Magnet Synchronous Motor. This motor churns out a healthy 180 kW (around 241 hp) and 236 lb-ft of instant torque, promising that classic Mazda "Jinba Ittai" driver-centric feel. Expect sharp handling, a well-balanced ride, and multiple regenerative braking modes for an engaging and efficient drive. It's shaping up to be a proper driver's EV!

#### Range, Battery & Charging

Powering your journeys in the 6e Long Range is a 75 kWh usable battery pack, delivering a Green Cars

Compare estimated real-world range of 291 miles – plenty for daily driving and weekend adventures! Efficiency is pegged at a solid 3.88 mi/kWh. For charging, the standard 11 kW onboard AC charger will juice it up overnight. When you're on the go, it can slurp up DC fast charging at up to 95 kW. While the EU model gets CCS Type 2, expect a US version to feature a CCS Type 1 or NACS port.

### **Safety & Driver-Assistance Features**

Mazda always puts safety first, and the 6e Long Range should be no exception. While official NHTSA and IIHS crash test ratings are pending its US arrival, expect it to aim for top marks. Mazda's comprehensive i-Activsense suite of driver-assistance systems will likely come standard. This typically includes goodies like adaptive cruise control, automatic emergency braking with pedestrian detection, lane-keeping assist, and blind-spot monitoring, keeping you and yours secure on every trip. More advanced features like a 360-degree camera could be on the options list.

### **Warranty & Maintenance Coverage**

When you get your hands on the 6e Long Range, expect Mazda's typical warranty coverage. This usually means a 3-year/36,000-mile basic limited warranty and a 5-year/60,000-mile powertrain warranty. Crucially for an EV, the battery pack will likely be covered by an 8-year/100,000-mile warranty, including protection against significant degradation. EVs mean less fuss with maintenance, but Mazda might sweeten the deal with some complimentary scheduled maintenance. Mazda's known for reliability, so fingers crossed this new EV platform continues that trend!

## How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Mazda 6e Long Range (2025-...) achieves a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 7.5 seconds (placing it at Nº59 out of 118 ranked positions, among 953 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and attains a maximum speed of 109 mph.

Its powertrain provides a power output of up to 180 kW (241 hp) and a torque of 236 lb-ft.

# How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Mazda 6e Long Range (2025-...) achieves a real-world range of 291 miles, placing it at №85 among 264 ranked positions. However, this range is subject to several influences:

- Speed: Traveling at higher speeds reduces battery life.
- Temperature: Extreme cold or hot weather can affect range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous landscapes decrease range.
- Driving habits: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Feature usage: Climate control and media systems also influence range.

It's important to acknowledge that these are estimations, and your actual driving range may differ. Consider these factors when planning your trip and be ready for potential charging stops.

# What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The Mazda 6e Long Range (2025-...) in the USA comes with a CCS Type 2 charging port. It can be

charged at home using a standard domestic socket or at any public AC charging station with the compatible cable. It's important to note that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11 kW, resulting in approximately 38 miles of range added per hour of charging.

For significantly faster charging, public DC fast-charging stations are available. Although the car can achieve a maximum DC charging rate of 95 kW, factors such as battery temperature and charge level may affect the actual charging speed.

## How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

The size and weight specifications for Mazda 6e Long Range (2025-...) are as follows:

• Length: 193.7 in

• Width: 84.9 in (including side mirrors) or 74.4 in (excluding side mirrors)

• Height: 58.7 in

Wheelbase: 114 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)

• Curb weight: 4306 lbs (weight of the empty car, no people or cargo)

## How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

The rear cargo area of the Mazda 6e Long Range (2025-...) provides 11.7 cubic feet of space when the rear seats are upright (Nº131 out of 163 ranked positions, among 953 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding these seats down unlocks a maximum cargo capacity of 37.9 cubic feet (№160 out of 197 ranked positions, among 953 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

In addition, the car has a frunk, a front compartment with 2.5 cubic feet dedicated to smaller items.

## Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Mazda 6e Long Range (2025-...) is officially rated to tow 3307 lbs. This applies to trailers equipped with brakes.
