About Honda Prologue AWD (2025-...)

The Honda Prologue AWD (2025-...) is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2025 replacing the older Honda Prologue AWD (2024-2025). Brand new, the car starts around \$50,400. The car is not available on the US market.

The Honda Prologue AWD (2025-...) has a 85 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 279 mi on a single charge — ranked №290 out of 918 electric vehicles.

How powerful is it? How fast does it accelerate?

The Honda Prologue AWD (2025-...) achieves a 0 to 60 mph acceleration in 5.9 seconds (placing it at №43 out of 118 ranked positions, among 918 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions) and attains a maximum speed of 115 mph.

Its powertrain provides a power output of up to 223 kW (300 hp) and a torque of 355 lb-ft.

How far can it go on single charge? What is the real-world range?

Honda Prologue AWD (2025-...) achieves a real-world range of 279 miles, placing it at №95 among 260 ranked positions. However, this range is subject to several influences:

- Speed: Traveling at higher speeds reduces battery life.
- Temperature: Extreme cold or hot weather can affect range.
- Terrain: Hilly or mountainous landscapes decrease range.
- Driving habits: Aggressive driving with frequent acceleration and braking consumes more energy.
- Feature usage: Climate control and media systems also influence range.

It's important to acknowledge that these are estimations, and your actual driving range may differ. Consider these factors when planning your trip and be ready for potential charging stops.

What charging options are available? How long does it take to charge it?

The Honda Prologue AWD (2025-...) in the USA comes with a CCS Type 1 charging port. It can be charged at home using a standard domestic socket or at any public AC charging station with the compatible cable. It's important to note that the car's on-board charger (inverter) limits the maximum AC charging rate to 11.5 kW, resulting in approximately 35 miles of range added per hour of charging.

For significantly faster charging, public DC fast-charging stations are available. Although the car can achieve a maximum DC charging rate of 155 kW, factors such as battery temperature and charge level may affect the actual charging speed.

How big is it? What are the dimensions (length, width, height)?

The size and weight specifications for Honda Prologue AWD (2025-...) are as follows:

• Wheelbase: 121.8 in (distance between the center of the front and rear wheels)

How much cargo space does it offer? Does it have a front trunk?

The rear cargo area of the Honda Prologue AWD (2025-...) provides 25.2 cubic feet of space when the rear seats are upright (Nº41 out of 159 ranked positions, among 918 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

Folding these seats down unlocks a maximum cargo capacity of 57.7 cubic feet (Nº68 out of 187 ranked positions, among 918 electric vehicles, with some cars sharing positions).

The car doesn't have a "frunk" (front trunk).

Is it suitable for towing? What is the maximum towing capacity?

The Honda Prologue AWD (2025-...) is officially rated to tow 1500 lbs. This applies to trailers equipped with brakes.
