The Ford Focus Electric 33 kWh is an all-electric front-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2017 replacing the older Ford Focus Electric 23 kWh. Ford stopped making the 33 kWh in 2018.

The Ford Focus Electric 33 kWh has a 33.5 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 110 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 28.9 kWh per 100 miles (or 289 Wh/mile) — ranked №541 out of 586 electric vehicles.
