The Mercedes EQC 400 4MATIC is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2020. Mercedes stopped making the 400 4MATIC in 2023. The car is not available on the US market.

The Mercedes EQC 400 4MATIC has a 85 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 216 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 37 kWh per 100 miles (or 370 Wh/mile) — ranked №354 out of 586 electric vehicles.
