



Renault ZOE Q90 (Europe)

The Renault ZOE Q90 is an all-electric front-wheel drive hatchback. It came out in 2018 replacing the older Renault ZOE Q210. Renault stopped making the Q90 in 2019 and replaced it with the Renault ZOE R110. The car is not available on the US market.

The Renault ZOE Q90 has a 44.1 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 172 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 23.8 kWh per 100 miles (or 238 Wh/mile) — ranked №453 out of 586 electric vehicles.
