



Tesla Model S 60 (2015) (Europe)

The Tesla Model S 60 (2015) is an all-electric rear-wheel drive liftback. It came out in 2013. Tesla stopped making the 60 (2013) in 2015 and replaced it with the Tesla Model S 70 (2015). You can still find Tesla Model S 60 (2015) on the used car market, with prices starting around \$13,990.

The Tesla Model S 60 (2015) has a 61 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 191 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 30.6 kWh per 100 miles (or 306 Wh/mile) — ranked №412 out of 586 electric vehicles.
