



## Tesla Model S 100D (Europe)

The Tesla Model S 100D is an all-electric all-wheel drive liftback. It came out in 2017 replacing the older Tesla Model S 90D (2016). Tesla stopped making the 100D in 2019 and replaced it with the Tesla Model S Long Range. You can still find Tesla Model S 100D on the used car market, with prices starting around \$22,999.

The Tesla Model S 100D has a 100 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 315 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 30.2 kWh per 100 miles (or 302 Wh/mile) — ranked №63 out of 586 electric vehicles.
