



Audi e-tron Sportback 50 quattro (Europe)

The Audi e-tron Sportback 50 quattro is an all-electric all-wheel drive SUV. It came out in 2020. Audi stopped making the 50 quattro in 2022 and replaced it with the Audi Q8 Sportback e-tron 50 quattro. The car is not available on the US market.

The Audi e-tron Sportback 50 quattro has a 71 kWh battery pack, allowing it to travel up to 173 mi on a single charge. The car has an average efficiency of 37.4 kWh per 100 miles (or 374 Wh/mile) — ranked №452 out of 586 electric vehicles.
